

## IFSEA MEMBERS TAKE KEY ROLES IN NATIONAL CONFERENCE

Atlanta will serve as the host city for the 2011 National Child Support Enforcement Association (NCSEA) Annual Conference. The event takes place August 1-3, 2011 at the Atlanta Hilton Hotel. Over 500 Child Support professionals from across the United States and several foreign countries as well as federal officials and contractors will gather to learn, share and train. Former Georgia Chief Justice Leah Ward Sears will be the opening plenary keynote speaker. Justice Sears was the first African-American female Chief Justice of any state Supreme Court in the United States. OCSE Commissioner Vicky Turetsky will provide a luncheon address.
